



# ELFIN SPORTS CARS

Garrie Cooper began building Elfin Cars in the late 1950's in a modest factory in Conmurra Street, Edwardstown, Adelaide. The factory went on to produce 250 racing and sports/racing cars during the next 24 years. Elfins were ultimately involved in 24 major Australian and overseas Championship victories. Garrie was awarded the Membership of Honour from the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport and the Advance Australia Award for "Outstanding contribution to Motorsport"
